ASSISTANT MAINTENANCE JOB DESCRIPTION FOR LAKEVIEW VILLAGES

Required Qualifications

- 1. Minimum age 18 years old and completed one year in a post-secondary educational program.
- 2. Mature, capable, mechanically-oriented person.
- 3. Working knowledge of basic maintenance, repair, and grounds work.
- 4. Desire and ability to work in a camp setting.
- 5. As a representative of Lakeview Ministries, agrees to demonstrate a lifestyle and teach Christian doctrine in accordance with the beliefs of the Lutheran Church-Missouri Synod.

Desired Qualifications

- 1. Member in good standing of the Lutheran Church-Missouri Synod.
- 2. Ability to accept guidance and supervision from others and to work with others.
- 3. Ability to train, lead and supervise junior staff.
- 4. Organized and self-motivated, with the initiative to find work that needs to be done without being told.
- 5. Possess imagination, a sense of humor, patience, conviction, sincerity, enthusiasm, initiative, self-control, adaptability, willingness to learn, integrity, ingenuity, a sense of spiritual direction, and the presence of God in his/her life.

To Whom Responsible

- 1. The Executive Director and Program Director in terms of application and employment, training and work assignments, as well as personnel policies and practices.
- 2. The Director of Facilities in all areas related to grounds work, maintenance, repairs, janitorial duties, and other regular or special work duties.

General Responsibilities

- 1. To help maintain the grounds and facilities of Camp Lakeview and Lakeview Villages to ensure a safe, healthy, attractive, and functional environment.
- 2. Possess an attitude and actions which continually reflect that Christ lives within you and that you view your position as an opportunity to be in His service.

Specific Responsibilities

- 1. Assist the Director of Facilities to train, schedule, assign, and supervise Junior Counselors and Junior Maintenance with regard to grounds work, maintenance, or housekeeping duties.
- 2. With the exceptions of the full-time staff and individuals designated by the Executive Director, be the sole driver and operator of the camp's tractor, utility vehicles, and riding mowers.

- 3. Assist with the mowing of all grass, using the camp's tractor, riding mower, push mowers, and trimmers.
- 4. Trim bushes periodically and remove dead branches, stumps, or trees when necessary.
- 5. Trim existing trails, keeping branches away from heads of pedestrians.
- 6. Supervise and be responsible for the daily picking up of trash from the villages.
- 7. Supervise and be responsible for the daily cleaning of the porches of the village lodge.
- 8. Keep Village bathhouses stocked with housekeeping supplies.
- 9. Assist High Ropes Coordinators with maintenance and repair of high ropes challenge course.
- 10. Collect trash from all receptacles and dispose of properly.
- 11. Assist the Director of Facilities in ordering and stocking necessary maintenance or housekeeping supplies.
- 12. Make recommendations to the Director of Facilities for equipment purchases.
- 13. Assist in moving materials and supplies to appropriate areas in camp as needed.
- 14. Assist the Director of Facilities in maintaining the camp's fleet of vehicles, lawn mowers, and power tools in good working order.
- 15. Inspect and repair fleet of mountain bikes, weekly.
- 16. Make sure all maintenance equipment and tools are properly returned to their storage area.
- 17. Repair/replace any damaged equipment which is brought to your attention by other personnel.
- 18. Keep all woodpiles stocked.
- 19. Help clean the camp on Friday afternoons in preparation for the closing program.
- 20. Weekly check and inflate all athletic balls and inner-tubes. Repair if necessary.
- 21. Attend required staff meetings.
- 22. Evaluate current operations and make recommendations as they arise.
- 23. Be available for emergency repairs.
- 24. On occasion lead Bible study and camper devotions.
- 25. As a team member, assist other staff in any task that will enhance the outdoor ministry of Lakeview Villages.
