## TIERED PRICING

**(Camp is for everyone!)**

We believe in the immense value of a Christian camp experience for everyone. Tiered pricing allows families to choose the price that works best for them, and offers the opportunity to take an active role in supporting the true cost of a camp experience.

- **Tier A** prices reflect the TRUE COST of a camp experience.
- **Tier B** prices are partially subsidized by donors.
- **Tier C** prices are significantly subsidized by donors.

All campers receive the same high quality camp experience regardless of what tier they pay, and all families are free to choose the option that works best for them. When registering, simply select the tier of your choice. Your selection is completely confidential.

We also offer financial aid and scholarships to assist with the cost of camp.

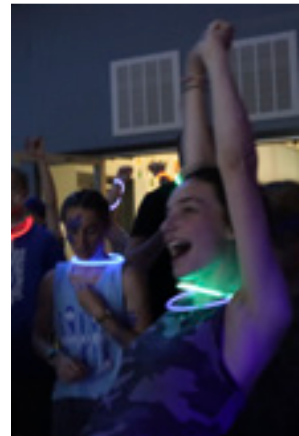
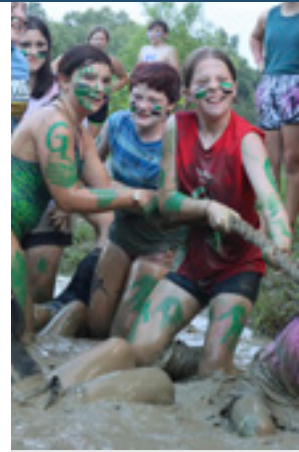
## Senior High Camp

## REGISTRATION INFORMATION

### How to Register

Registration opens on **Tuesday, February 1st at 9:00 am EST**. Prior to this date you will be able to log in or create your online account to ensure all your information is up to date. Registration is done online at [lakeview.camp](http://lakeview.camp).

### Deposit and Payments

A \$100 deposit is required for all Camp Lakeview and Lakeview Villages sessions. A \$25 deposit (per person) is required for Family sessions. You have not secured your spot until you pay the deposit. **Full payment for your camp session is REQUIRED two weeks prior to your scheduled arrival.**

### Registration Confirmation

Upon registering, you should receive an email within 24 hours confirming your registration. **Please contact our office if you do not.**

### Wait List:

If a session is full, completing the registration process will add your camper to the wait list for that session. (No deposit required.) You may still register for a different session while on the wait list, and transfer if a spot opens up. As openings become available they are offered in order of initial wait list sign-up. (NO EXCEPTIONS will be made to this order.) You will have limited time to respond to an offer so make sure the email and phone number associated with your account are ones you check regularly.

### Grade Level:

All grade levels are based on the camper's current (2021-2022) school year.

### Cabin Mate Requests:

Please minimize requests as much as possible. We value giving campers the space to make new friends. We will do our best to honor up to FOUR cabin mate requests, **but prefer only ONE or TWO**. Cabin mates must mutually choose each other for requests to be honored.

### Financial Aid:

Scholarships are available to help with the cost of camp. We want EVERYONE to be able to come to camp, regardless of financial situation. Go to [lakeview.camp/financialaid](http://lakeview.camp/financialaid) to download a request form.

### Cancellation Policy:

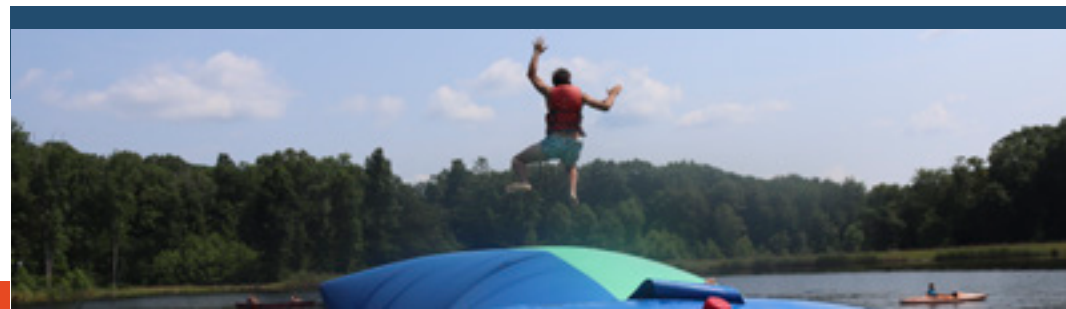
Refunds will be granted 14 days prior to your scheduled arrival for all but \$25 of your deposit. No refunds will be granted within 14 days of your scheduled arrival except in cases of illness, injury or family emergencies.

### Multiple Sessions:

Due to the high demand for Camp Lakeview and Lakeview Villages sessions, campers may initially only register for one of these sessions. After **March 1st** campers may register for an additional session.
