As I think about the year behind us and look to the year ahead, the phrase "back to the future" comes to mind. Throughout 2021, our focus was on the here and now. With staffing changes, a postponed capital campaign, and—of course—COVID, we concentrated our efforts on figuring out how best to serve you during this time, and to be honest, how simply to survive.

Thanks to God's faithfulness and your continued support, we have been able to weather all those changes in ways beyond anything I could have ever imagined. Take our staffing situation, for example. This last year has seen several transitions as we focused on moving key people into open positions. We transitioned Frisbee to a new role as the Retreat Program Director. We filled her previous role as the Camp Lakeview Program Director with Brandon Hall, who dove headlong into summer 2021 with renewed energy as a new staff member. And now, I'm especially excited about Danny stepping into the Director of Operations role. His passion for Lakeview, coupled with his track record of staff development, made him an ideal candidate, and I'm thrilled for us to be firing on all cylinders with our staff in the coming year.

But God's faithfulness didn't end there. Our supporters in 2021 stepped up in a big way. Heading into our annual auction, we had already exceeded our normal giving, making up for shortfalls we incurred with limited camp enrollment last summer. With 275 people at the event and 75 people who participated remotely, we met our special donation goal of \$40,000, with overall receipts from ticket purchases and item sales reaching nearly \$80,000. Beyond the exceptional giving, however, it was simply wonderful to be in fellowship again, celebrating all that happened throughout the year. (Please make plans now to come back for another fun evening on November 19, 2022!)

Now, because of that support and God's faithfulness, we are able to look to the future, knowing that we are able to step into 2022 on a solid financial footing. We are so excited for another summer of camp, especially as we plan on returning to full capacity this year. Registration opens February 1, 2022, so be sure to get online and reserve your spot for what I know will be a wonderful experience this year!

Finally, as we transition into 2022, I'm thrilled to get back to our next steps for Lakeview. We're re-launching our capital campaign, A Place for You, ensuring that Lakeview will remain a place where we see lives transformed and faith in our Lord Jesus strengthened and renewed. For those who supported us and prayed for us through all these transitions, thank you! I can't wait to get back to the future with you!

MEET THE NEW DIRECTOR OF OPERATIONS!



Danny Frastaci is no stranger to
Lakeview Ministries, having worked as
the Lakeview Villages Program Director
since 2013. Those years of experience,
along with his strong ties at Lakeview,
make Danny the ideal choice as camp's
next Director of Operations. His love for
Jesus, passion to grow campers and staff,
and proven leadership will continue to
serve Lakeview and its guests as he
steps into this new role.

Ironically, Danny's first experience in Christian camping occurred—not as a camper—but as a summer camp counselor at Camp Perkins, Idaho. Born and raised in Cleveland, Ohio, Danny thought a job as a summer camp counselor would be fun. Little did he know that one experience would change the trajectory of his entire life.

"I was born and raised in the Lutheran church," he said, "but I had never been to camp. I showed up without any experience whatsoever. I saw these people dancing and singing around a campfire and wondered what this was all about. Once I got to know them and see them live out their faith daily," he continued, "I knew that was who I wanted to be. It was a pivotal moment for me."

In fact, camp changed Danny's views on faith entirely. "Thanks to camp, faith was no longer just a part of me that happened on Sunday mornings or when I was reading my Bible before going to bed. Faith became something I lived out each and every day and each and every moment."

That's why creating opportunities for people to step away from their everyday lives and grow in their faith is so important to Danny in his job. "I love getting to see people laugh and be rejuvenated by their time here," he said. "There's something new and different every day."

In his new position, Danny hopes to spend time investing in staff, guiding them as they take on new responsibilities, build programs, and grow in their own leadership roles. "I'm looking forward to working with our team to focus on overall staff development," he said.

According to Danny, one of the biggest impacts he sees happen at camp is the relationships staff build with campers. "We really encourage our staff to be open and vulnerable with the kids," he said. "Our staff isn't perfect. They're broken and sinful, just like everybody else. We want the campers to know that a Christian is someone who recognizes their brokenness but also knows they have a Savior who died to redeem us from our failings. We want them to know that they're not perfect. That's why we have Jesus Christ."

In addition to investing in the staff's physical, social, emotional, and spiritual health, Danny will be working with executive director Dave Vandercar on vision casting for camp and rebooting the capital campaign that was launched in 2019, then put on hold during COVID. "We've been blessed to have had many pledges come in," he said. "I'm so thankful for everyone who is generously partnering with us in making a difference in the next generation. We're excited to start moving forward with some of those projects."
