## How to Sign Up For Camp

Registration is done online at [lakeview.camp](https://lakeview.camp). Click the big blue "Register" button to create or log in to your camper account

### Pre-Registration

Because of the high demand for our programs, we hold a Pre-Registration sign up time (that happens before normal registration) to allow each camper an equal chance at getting into a camp session for the summer.

All campers who sign up during this time will be placed into a pool to be sorted according to their listed session choices and preferences. This is NOT based on order of sign up. Signing up at any point during Pre-Registration gives you the best chance to receive your top choice session.

Once Pre-Registration ends, any remaining open spots are available to sign up for during normal Registration.

## Important Dates

### February 1-3: Pre-Registration

Sign up your camper for your top choice session, then list your 2nd and 3rd choice sessions along with preferences regarding siblings and friends. Once signed up, wait for camp staff to sort campers into matching sessions. No payment is required for pre-registration. Family Sessions are NOT part of this early sign up.

### February 4-7: Pre-Registration Sorting

Camp staff will sort campers into sessions. Once your camper has been sorted, you will receive an email notifying you of their registration. At this time you will have TWO WEEKS to pay the deposit to secure their spot.

### February 8 at 9:00 am: Normal Registration OPENS

Registration opens for all Camp Sessions and Family Sessions on a first-come first-serve basis.

## Important Changes for 2024

- You must list at least two session options if signing up during Pre-Registration
- No "chained" friend requests will be allowed during Pre-Registration.
- Any "chained" groups larger than 5 campers will be split into two groups by the best judgement of the camp staff and will not be considered in preferences when sorting campers into sessions.

# Important Information

## How to Register

Pre-Registration (for Camp Lakeview and Villages sessions) is available from **February 1st-3rd**. Normal Registration (including registration for Family Sessions) begins on **Thursday, February 8th at 9:00 am EST**. Prior to these dates you will be able to log in or create your online account to ensure all your information is up to date. Registration is done online at [lakeview.camp](http://lakeview.camp).

## Grade Level

All grade levels are based on the camper's grade PRIOR to the summer. For the well-being of the program, campers, and staff, we do not make exceptions for camper grade.

## Tiered Pricing (Camp is for Everyone)

When registering, you will be able to select your choice of three different tier options. Tier A prices (the highest tier) reflect the TRUE COST of a camp experience. Tiered pricing allows families to choose the price that works best for them and keeps camp for everyone. **Your selection is completely up to you and completely confidential.**

## Financial Aid

Finances a little tight this year? Please make use of our financial aid program – we want EVERYONE to be able to come to camp, regardless of finances.

## Cabin Mate Requests

Please limit requests. The camp experience is enhanced when campers have space to make new friends. The maximum number of requests allowed is four, but **ONE or TWO is greatly preferred**. Any "chained" groups larger than five will be automatically split into two separate groups. Requests must be mutual to be honored.

## Waitlist

If a session is full, complete the registration process to add your camper to the waitlist (no deposit will be required). **You may still register for a different session while on the waitlist**, and transfer if a spot opens up.

Campers are contacted off the waitlist as soon as a spot becomes available, up to the first day of the session. Spots are offered in order of initial waitlist sign-up, but campers who have not yet attended a session are given priority. You have limited time to respond to an offer so **make sure the email and phone number associated with your account are ones you check regularly.**

## Multiple Sessions

Due to the high demand for Camp Lakeview and Lakeview Villages sessions, campers may initially **only register for one** of these sessions. After March 1st campers may register for an additional session.

## Deposit and Payments

A \$100 deposit is required for all Camp Lakeview and Lakeview Villages sessions. A \$25 deposit (per person) is required for Family sessions. You have not secured your spot until you pay the deposit. **Full payment for your camp session is REQUIRED two weeks prior to your scheduled arrival.**

## Cancellation Policy

Refunds will be granted 14 days prior to the start of your session for all but \$25 of your deposit. No refunds will be granted within 14 days of the start of your session except in cases of illness, injury or family emergencies.
