Weekend rates apply for rentals spanning ANY part of Friday afternoon through Sunday afternoon.

Mohegan + Quapaw + Village Lodge: \$12.50/person/night + Flat Fee

#### Village Lodge (sleeps 44)

Weekend: \$700Midweek: \$400

#### Mohegan Lodge (sleeps 32)

#### **Quapaw Lodge (sleeps 28)**

#### Flat Fees

Weekend: \$425 flat fee (covers 2 nights) + \$95/additional night

#### **RV and Tent Camping** (Only available to groups already renting another facility)

#### **DINING AND MEETING FACILITIES**

For groups wishing to cook for themselves, a **self-cooking surcharge** of \$100 will be added to use our kitchen facilities. This fee helps cover the costs of utilities, housekeeping, and maintaining cookware.

#### Shelterhouse (seats 80)

• Overnight Groups: \$150 minus all housing charges

Day Groups: \$150 or \$5/person, whichever is greater

#### Camp Lakeview Dining Hall Exclusive Use (seats 150)

• Weekend: \$1800 minus all housing charges

• Midweek: \$300 or \$5/person (minus programming charges), whichever is greater

#### Village Lodge Upstairs (seats 150)

Weekend: \$1200 minus all housing chargers

Midweek: \$300, or \$5/person (minus programming charges), whichever is greater

**Self-Cooking Surcharge**: \$100

#### IMPORTANT INFORMATION TO KNOW

#### **Calendar Rental Restrictions**

The following dates are time periods when NO rentals are allowed due to programming and holidays:

• May 10-August 4: Summer Rental Freeze

• Nov 21-24: Thanksgiving Rental Freeze

• Dec 23-Jan 1: Christmas Rental Freeze

#### **Early Set Up Fee**

In general, groups may NOT set up prior to their contracted start date. If early set up is arranged with camp in advance, an early set up fee will be charged.

Early Set Up Fee: \$50

#### **Transportation Fee**

If extra camp staff are required to provide transportation around camp, a transportation fee will be charged.

Transportation Fee: \$100

### **Lakeview Ministries Food Service Information**

Thank you for your interest in enjoying some delicious meals while at camp! All meal service must be arranged at least **FOUR WEEKS** in advance of your stay, and total numbers (for the purpose of food orders) must be given no later than **TWO WEEKS** in advance of your stay.

#### RATES

Prices are per-person with a minimum charge of 15 people per meal.

#### **Kid-Oriented Menu**

Meal: \$8.50Snack: \$2

This menu provides meals that are oriented more towards children (such as hot dogs, pizza, and chicken nuggets). The salad bar includes a basic side salad.

#### **Adult-Oriented Menu**

Meal: \$10Snack \$5

This menu provides meals that are oriented more towards adults (such as pulled pork, ham and potatoes, and lasagna). The salad bar includes a side salad with additional toppings.

Day groups not staying overnight at camp will be charged an additional \$1/person/meal.

#### Self-Cooking

When available, groups are able to rent our kitchen facilities to cook for themselves. For such groups, a self-cooking surcharge of **\$100** will be added. This fee helps cover the costs of utilities, housekeeping, and maintaining cookware. In addition, <u>all such groups are required to attend a staff-led kitchen orientation at the start of their stay.</u>

#### IMPORTANT POLICIES TO KNOW

#### General

- Total numbers for each meal must be provided **TWO WEEKS** prior to the week of your group's arrival. If your group numbers change after, you will still be charged 90% of these numbers or the actual number of diners, whichever is greater.
- Meals are provided at 8:00 am, 12:00 pm, and 5:30 pm. We may be able to accommodate requests for different meal times, but such requests should be made at least FOUR WEEKS prior to the week of your group's arrival.
- Snacks may NOT be served in place of regular meals.

#### **Food Allergies**

- All food allergies must be communicated TWO WEEKS prior to the week of your group's arrival. Our kitchen is able to provide basic alternatives for typical food allergies such as gluten or dairy but needs to know about them ahead of time.
- If a member of your group has more severe or extensive allergies <u>we recommend they</u> <u>bring supplemental food items to camp</u>. Our kitchen staff is able to cook, microwave, and prepare separate food items for meals.
- A **menu** for your time at camp can be provided upon request to help you better plan and prepare.

#### **Menu Options**

- In general, our kitchen staff will set the menu for your time at camp. If you have a special
  meal or menu request for your group it must be communicated FOUR WEEKS in
  advance of your stay.
- We may not be able to accommodate your request.
- Menu changes incur an additional fee of \$25 due to the increased time and logistics required.
- Special meals will be priced on a meal by meal basis. When a special meal is requested your group will receive a price quote.

## **Lakeview Ministries Activity Information:**

Lakeview Ministries provides a wide variety of self-led activities for groups to enjoy on their own at camp. The majority of these activities are FREE.

We also have certain staff-led activities available to schedule. Staff-led activities must be scheduled at least 1 MONTH in advance and are entirely dependent on staff availability-so make sure you have alternative plans!

Activities are limited to the side of camp you are renting from unless special permission is given.

#### **SELF-LED ACTIVITIES**

Free unless otherwise indicated. Activities with fees must be set up in advance.

#### **Camp Lakeview:**

- Athletic Field Games Camp Lakeview has soccer goals, volleyball nets, and sports equipment for dodgeball, kickball, ultimate frisbee, etc.

#### STAFF-LED ACTIVITIES

**\$30/staff member/hour** unless otherwise indicated. Activities must be scheduled at least 1 MONTH in advance and are entirely dependent on staff availability.

Certain special rates available for school and church groups.

#### **Camp Lakeview:**

#### • Archery and Slingshot Range

6 people can shoot at once.

#### Group Games

Examples of games include variations of Capture the Flag, Dodgeball, etc.

#### • Canoeing + Mini Kayaks

Max 30 people/lifeguard. We have 10 canoes and 20 kayaks.

#### Creek Stomping

Be led on an expedition through the creek that runs through camp.

#### • Devotions and Campfire Worship Leading (FREE)

We would love to lead devotions for you free of charge. \*If only music leading is desired, there may be an hourly charge.\*

#### • Group Building / Low Ropes Challenge Course

Max 20 people/staff member.

#### Horseback Riding

Up to 8 people can ride at once with time for 2 long rides or 3 short rides per hour.

Rate: \$120 per hour + \$60 saddling fee.

#### Outdoor Education Course

Examples of courses include Tree Identification, Stargazing, Fire Building, etc.

#### Swimming

Max 30 people/lifeguard.

#### • Zip Lining

Roughly 20 people/hour can go down the zip line.

Rate: \$120 per hour + \$60 setup fee.

#### **Lakeview Villages:**

#### Archery Tag

Recommended for 6th grade and older. 14 people can play at once.

#### Archery Range

3 people can shoot at once.

#### • BB Gun Range

4 people can shoot at once.

#### • Devotions and Campfire Worship Leading (FREE)

We would love to lead times of singing and devotions for you free of charge. \*If only music leading is desired, there may be an hourly charge.\*

#### Hatchet Throwing

Recommended for 6th grade and older. 3 people can throw at once.

#### Archery/BB/Hatchet Combo

Doing all 3 activities at once is an option, but requires multiple staff members if your group wishes to do activities concurrently instead of doing one after the other.

#### Canoeing + Kayaks + Stand Up Paddleboards\*

Max 30 people/lifeguard. There are 6 canoes, 15 kayaks, and 2 paddleboards.

#### • Climbing Tower

3 walls for up to 3 people climbing at once. Roughly 6 people/wall/hour can climb. Rate: \$90 per hour + \$60 set up fee.

#### • Group Games

Examples of games include Capture the Flag, Dodgeball, Field Games, etc.

#### • Group Building / Low Ropes Challenge Course

Max 20 people/staff member.

#### • High Ropes Elements

For 6th grade and older ONLY. Only 1 element may be used at a time.

- Zip Line w/ Wire Traverse (\$120/hour + \$60 set up fee)
  - Roughly 15 people/hour can go down the zip line.
- Pamper Pole (\$60/hour + \$60 set up fee)
  - Roughly 12 people/hour can climb the Pamper Pole.
- Milk Crate Stacking (\$60/hour + \$60 set up fee)
  - Roughly 15 people/hour can attempt Milk Crate Stacking.
- Jacob's Ladder (\$60/hour + \$60 set up fee)
   Roughly 15 people/hour can climb Jacob's Ladder.

#### • Outdoor Education Course

Examples of courses include Tree Identification, Stargazing, Fire Building, etc.

#### • Swimming\*

Max 30 people/lifeguard.

\*At Lakeview Villages, family and adult groups ONLY are able to swim and boat on their own for free. All youth-based groups (such as school groups) MUST have a camp-provided lifeguard to use the lake.
