Weekend rates apply for rentals spanning ANY part of Friday afternoon through Sunday afternoon.

Lakeview Ministries Lodging Overview

At Lakeview Ministries we have two sides of camp, our **Camp Lakeview side** and our **Lakeview Villages side**. Each side is adjacent to Lake Road. It requires a short drive or a 10-15 minute walk to get from one side to the other.

All sleeping facilities are equipped with heating and air conditioning. All beds are twin-sized bunk beds.

Our **lodges** (Village Lodge, Mohegan, and Quapaw) offer dorm style accommodations with carpeted rooms containing two bunk beds, and shared bathrooms/showers a short walk down the hall.

Our **cabins** and **Village Clusters** offer more rustic accommodations with wood walls and brushed concrete floors, and a shared bathhouse/shower building that is a short outdoor walk away.

11 Cabins (132 total)

- 1 rooms x 12 people per cabin

Lakeview Villages side (174 beds)

- 8 rooms x 4 people
- 1 room x 8 people
- 1 room x 4 people (upstairs)

5 Village Clusters (26/cluster) (130 total)

- 2 rooms x 7 people per cluster
- 2 rooms x 6 people per cluster

*Linens can be provided (IN LODGES ONLY) for an additional fee.

Dining Accommodations

- **Camp Lakeview Dining Hall:** Can seat and serve up to **175 people**.
- **Lakeview Villages Village Lodge:** Can seat and serve up to **150 people**.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION TO KNOW BEFORE RENTING

Calendar Rental Restrictions

The following dates are time periods when **NO rentals** are allowed due to programming and holidays:

- **May 17-August 9 (2026)**: Summer Rental Freeze
- **Nov 26-29 (2026)**: Thanksgiving Rental Freeze
- **Dec 23-Jan 1 (2027)**: Christmas Rental Freeze
- **Mar 26-28 (2027)**: Easter Rental Freeze

Staff-Led Programming Restrictions

The following dates are time periods when **NO staff-led programming** is available to rental groups due to Lakeview retreats, events, or pre-arranged programming:

- **Aug 28-30 (2026)**
- **Sept 4-6 (2026)**
- **Sep 11-12 (2026)**
- **Nov 21-23 (2026)**
- **February 13-22 (2027)**
- **May 3-16 (2027)**

In addition, all staff-led camp activities are **weather dependent**. High Ropes activities and Water activities specifically are unable to occur in low temperature weather due to safety protocols.

ADDITIONAL FEES

Day Use Fee

In general, overnight groups are NOT allowed to bring participants over the sleeping capacity maximum of their rented facility unless given permission is arranged with camp in advance. This policy ensures all retreat groups have an optimal experience using our facilities.

If given permission, groups will pay a fee based on the number over the maximum.

Day Fee Ranges from # of Guests

- 0-10 Guests: \$25
- 10-25 Guests: \$100
- 25-50 Guests: \$200
- 50-75 Guests: \$300
- 75-100 Guests: \$500
- 100+ Guests: \$1000

Early Set Up Fee

In general, groups may **NOT** set up prior to their contracted start date. If early set up is arranged with camp in advance, an early set up fee will be charged.

Any early set up needs must be communicated via email or phone **at least two weeks in advance** and **cannot occur until after 9:00am** to ensure we have adequate staff available to help.

Early Set Up Fee: \$50

SLEEPING FACILITIES

The rates for our facilities, meals, programming, etc. cover the basic expenses of your stay at camp, but do not make a profit. We intentionally keep rates as low as possible to allow camp to be accessible to organizations, groups, and families. If you would like to support the life-changing ministry of camp, consider making a donation at lakeview.camp/give.

Mohegan + Quapaw + Village Lodge: \$13.00/person/night + Flat Fee

Flat Fees

Village Lodge (sleeps 44)

- Weekend: \$720
- Midweek: \$420

Mohegan Lodge (sleeps 32)

- Weekend: \$455
- Midweek: \$315

Quapaw Lodge (sleeps 28)

- Weekend: \$375
- Midweek: \$235

Linens (only available in lodges): \$10/set

Village Clusters (sleep 26): \$0/person/night + Flat Fee

Flat Fees

- Weekend: \$435 flat fee (covers 2 nights) + \$95/additional night
- Midweek: \$210 flat fee (covers 1 night) + \$95/additional night

Camp Lakeview Cabins (sleep 12): \$8/person/night + Flat Fee

Flat Fees

- Weekend: \$70
- Midweek: \$40

RV and Tent Camping (Only available to groups already renting another facility)

- RV Site: \$30/night
- Tent Camping: \$10/person/night

Winter Discount:

Any facilities rented in December & January will be charged our Midweek Flat Fee rate. Come to camp during the winter and save!

DINING AND MEETING FACILITIES

For groups using the Dining Hall or Village Lodge to cook for themselves, a **self-cooking surcharge** (based on group size) will be added to use our kitchen facilities. This fee helps cover the costs of utilities, kitchen equipment, cleaning, and maintaining cookware.

In addition, each self-cooking group is required to attend a kitchen orientation at the beginning of their retreat, and a kitchen check out at the end of their retreat to ensure proper health code and cleaning standards are followed.

Shelterhouse (seats 80)

- Overnight Groups: \$150 minus all housing charges
- Day Groups: \$150 or \$5/person, whichever is greater

Camp Lakeview Dining Hall* (seats and serves up to 175)

- Weekend: \$1800 minus all housing charges
- Midweek: \$300 (minus housing charges for overnight groups / programming charges for day groups) OR \$5/person, whichever is greater

Village Lodge Dining Area* (upstairs of building) (seats and serves up to 150)

- Weekend: \$1200 minus all housing charges
- Midweek: \$300 (minus housing charges for overnight groups / programming charges for day groups) OR \$5/person, whichever is greater

*Groups are charged for use of these spaces only if:

- The group is small enough that the housing charges don't cancel out the rate **AND**
- The group requires exclusive use of the dining hall. This can occur if the group is:
 - *Using the kitchen space to cook meals*
 - *Having programming needs that prevent other groups from using the space*
 - *Desiring private use of the space*

Self-Cooking Surcharge:

- Weekend: \$200 (+\$100 for groups >100)
- Single-Day: \$100 (+\$50 for groups >100)

Lakeview Ministries Food Service Information

Thank you for your interest in enjoying some delicious meals while at camp! All meal service must be arranged at least **FOUR WEEKS** in advance of your stay.

Meal Numbers (for the purpose of food orders) + **Food Allergy Needs** must be given NO LATER than **TWO WEEKS** in advance of your stay.

RATES

Prices are per person with a minimum charge of **15 people per meal**.

Standard Meal Rate: \$11/person/meal

Student Meal Rate*: \$9/person/meal

**The student menu rate is only available for school groups and youth retreats composed of students 14 years old and younger. Ask to see if your group qualifies.*

All menus provide an entrée, side, salad bar with additional toppings, and drinks. For additional information on our menus, go to LAKEVIEW.CAMP/FOOD.

Other Rate Information:

- **SNACKS** are also able to be provided at a rate of \$2 for a basic snack (ex. Granola Bar + Apple) and \$5 for a deluxe snack (ex. Popcorn Bar + Brownies).
- **DAY GROUPS** not staying overnight at camp will be charged an additional **\$1/person/meal**.

Self-Cooking

When available, groups are able to rent our kitchen facilities to cook for themselves. For such groups, a self-cooking surcharge will be added. This fee helps cover the costs of utilities, kitchen equipment, cleaning, and maintaining cookware

Any self-cooking group is **REQUIRED** to attend a kitchen orientation at the beginning of their retreat, and a kitchen check out at the end of their retreat to ensure proper health code and cleaning standards are followed.

IMPORTANT MEAL POLICIES TO KNOW

General

- Total numbers for each meal must be provided **TWO WEEKS** prior to the week of your group's arrival. If your group numbers change after, you will still be charged 90% of these numbers or the actual number of diners, whichever is greater.
- Meals are provided at 8:00 am, 12:00 pm, and 5:30 pm. We may be able to accommodate requests for different meal times, but such requests should be made at least **FOUR WEEKS** prior to the week of your group's arrival.
- Snacks may NOT be served in place of regular meals.

Food Allergy Needs

- For a full description of our ability to accommodate food allergies, go to LAKEVIEW.CAMP/FOOD.
- All food allergies must be communicated **TWO WEEKS** prior to the week of your group's arrival. Our kitchen is able to provide basic alternatives for typical food allergies such as **gluten** or **dairy** but needs to know about them ahead of time.
- A **menu** for your time at camp can be provided upon request to help you better plan and prepare.

Menu Options

- In general, our kitchen staff will set the menu for your time at camp. If you have a special meal or menu request for your group it must be communicated **FOUR WEEKS** in advance of your stay.
- We may not be able to accommodate your request.
- Menu changes incur an **additional fee** of **\$25** due to the increased time and logistics required.
- Special meals will be priced on a meal by meal basis. When a special meal is requested your group will receive a price quote.

Lakeview Ministries Activity Information:

Lakeview Ministries provides a wide variety of activities groups are able to enjoy on their own at camp. The majority of these activities are FREE.

Activities are limited to the side of camp you are renting from unless special permission is given.
